


There is a Solution

The problem of opioid misuse and addiction has grown to extreme proportions nationally and right here in northern Michigan. Abuse of prescription and illicit drugs such as heroin is claiming lives at an unprecedented rate.

In 2015, prescription opioid pain reliever and heroin related deaths totaled 33,000 in the U.S., more than any other year on record. Over 1,900 of those fatalities occurred in Michigan, and 37 people were lost in the 21-county NMRE region.

## ACCIDENTAL FATALITIES IN MICHIGAN

Prescription opioid pain reliever and heroin related deaths were the number one cause of injury related deaths in 2016, outpacing motor vehicle fatalities.
